Amendment to the Appendix of the Bylaws Regarding the Selection Procedure and Criteria for the Degree Programs in the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences

In accordance with § 10(1) of the Hamburg Admission to Higher Education in Hamburg Act dated 28 December 2004 (Hamburg Higher Education Admissions Act HZG) (HmbGVBI. p. 515), last amended on XXXXX, the Presidium of the University did on XXXXX ratify the amendment to the appendix of the Bylaws Regarding the Selection Procedure and Criteria for the Degree Programs of the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences dated 30 June 2005 and last amended on XXXXX adopted by the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences on 6 April 2011.

§ 1

The appendix of the Bylaws Regarding the Selection Procedure and Criteria for the Degree Programs in the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences shall be amended as follows:

Under Part B. X. The master's degree program in applied and molecular botany shall be amended as follows:

X. Master of Science in Molecular Plant Science

If the number of applications which satisfy the special conditions of admission completely or by the requisite total of 150 credit points for bachelor degree programs for conditional admission exceed the number of available space in the master's degree program in molecular plant science, then student selection shall be made as follows:

- a) Results of the first higher education degree
- b) Participation in a university exchange program (e.g., Erasmus, DAAD)
- c) Internships (at least 4 weeks) with a clear connection to the content of the master's degree program in molecular plant science
- d) At least 2 months' experience in a foreign country

Each of the activities completed in b) through d) will improve the grade of the first degree by 0.1. Ranking shall be calculated based on the final grade resulting from the addition of the aforementioned points.
